Donation Policy

The purpose of the Donation Policy is to guide the club in regards to requests received for donations. This policy will provide guidance for the types and amounts of donations generally acceptable, keeping in mind the club's Mission Statement; "to further the association of persons interested in pleasure horses and to promote social and educational activities based on horses".

All donations go before a vote of the general membership at a regular monthly meeting.

Donation Types

The preferable types of acceptable donations would be:

- Equine related (i.e. horse rescue groups, etc.)
- Youth equine related (i.e. qualification to 4H Nationals, Breed Nationals, etc.)
- Local community services (i.e. local Fire Dept., etc.)
- Club member related

Donation Amounts

The club will designate a yearly donation maximum dollar amount as part of the annual budget process. This amount will become final upon the approval of the budget by the general membership.

- A standard amount of not more than \$50.00 will be the limit of an individual monetary donation.
- A donation may take the form of the use of the grounds (i.e. 4H horse show).
- A donation may take the form of the use of our membership as volunteers.
- A donation may take the form of the use of equipment.

Fundraisers

The club may decide to sponsor a fundraiser for a person or organization meeting our type requirements. This could be in the form of a dinner, horse show, etc. All proceeds specifically raised for a cause may be donated without affecting the annual budgeted amount. Reimbursement of supplies/expenses from the money raised is assumed unless specified as donated.
