## **Harmony Riders Association Horse Show Rules**

## Division:

Lead Line	Exhibitor 6 years and under as of January 1 <sup>st</sup> . Handler must be age 18 years or older. May not cross enter into any other division.
Pee Wee	Youth or other exhibitor unable to ride unattended. Walk Trot. Handler must be age 18 years or older. May not cross enter into any other division.
Beginner	Exhibitor 10 years and under as of January 1 <sup>st</sup> . Walk Trot. May not cross enter into any other division.
Walk Trot	Exhibitor 11 years and older as of January 1 <sup>st</sup>
Junior A	Exhibitor 13 years and under as of January 1 <sup>st</sup>
Junior B	Exhibitor 14 – 18 years as of January 1 <sup>st</sup>
Senior	Exhibitor 19 years and over as of January 1 <sup>st</sup>

- 1. All horses on grounds must have a current Negative Coggins and Rabies Certificate
- 2. All dogs must have a rabies certificate and be on a leash
- 3. All exhibitors must be a member of Harmony Riders
- 4. Entry fees are \$6.00 unless otherwise noted
- 5. Office Fee \$6.00 per horse/rider combination
- 6. Ribbons to 6 places
- 7. Paybacks 50% club 50% rider
- 8. All ages are as of January 1st and proof of age may be requested at any time
- 9. Number goes on horse/rider combination
- 10. Horse rider combination must enter 2 additional classes for all added money classes
- 11. There is no limit to the number of years a Horse/Rider combination may receive a division award
- 12. A horse may enter a class only once
- 13. Heeled boots and collared shirts/proper attire required for all classes/discipline shown
- 14. All youth 18 and under in Leadline/Pee Wee/Beginner/Trot/Jr. A/Jr. B division must wear an ASTM helmet
- 15. Tack changes must be reported at time of sign in and are subject to a five minute time limit
- 16. Reruns needed due to tack failure will be granted only if rider reports the failure before leaving the ring
- 17. If a timer error occurs rider will be granted rerun at that time or at the end of the class
- 18. Any course equipment used on any horse as a whip will result in disqualification
- 19. At the show committee's/judge's discretion, a contestant may be disqualified for excessive use of hand, bat, crop, whip, rope or bit
- 20. Gymkhana riders may not run prior to red marked post in chute or you will be disqualified
- 21. Walking/leading a horse and rider in the ring will not be permitted in any class except Leadline and Pee
- 22. Year end and day end awards for each division
- 23. No refunds.
- 24. SHOW COMMITTEE/JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL
